The Coming of the Promised Holy Spirit Acts 2:42-43

How do I know if I gladly received the word of God?

(1) "And they continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine..." (Acts 2.42) Sunday School is the best place to receive the Word.

2) Fellowship (Acts 2.42) -- "...in the breaking of bread,"

Fellowship is experienced as we do the work of God together.

- Genuine fellowship is from God
- Fellowship builds strong personal relationships.
- Genuine fellowship fosters the love of Christ
- Fellowship is a gift from Christ.
- Others benefit from fellowship with us.

Sunday School is the best place to participate in Biblical fellowship.

(3) Prayer (Acts 2.42) -- The Biblical purpose of prayer is personal transformation.

- Prayer is an opportunity to bring our will into line with God's plan.
- Prayer is an opportunity to demonstrate our trust in God.
- Prayer reflects our dependence on God
- We should pray with confidence in God's grace
- We should pray with humility and sincerity
- Weekly prayer guide for our Church (Evangelism)

Sunday School is the best place to pray with fellow believers.

4) "...fear came upon every soul" -- (Acts 2.43) Malachi 1:6 (NKJV) ⁶"A son honors *his* father, And a servant *his* master. If then I am the Father, Where *is* My honor? And if I *am* a Master, Where *is* My reverence? Says the LORD of hosts To you priests who despise My name. Yet you say, 'In what way have we despised Your name?'

According to these verses what was the end result of those people gladly receiving the Word of God?

"...and many wonders and signs were done through the apostles." (Metonymically of persons sent from God, whose character and acts are a manifestation of the divine power, things out of the ordinary.)
